The 43rd AGM was held on Monday the 26th June 2017 from 10.00 a.m. at 4th Floor, J Corporate Box, KSCA, Bengaluru. The Meeting started by invoking the blessings of the God by Sri Chander Kulkarni.

The President in his address thanked all the Working Committee members for their excellent co-operation. He further informed that in line with AGM decision not to collect the annual donation of Rs.300/- from the members who attains 60

years of age since posting of matches for them has been stopped. It was decided to exempt those umpires above 60 years of age from payment of Rs.300/- towards annual donation to ACUK. However, in such cases where members services were utilised by KSCA as Match Officials etc., may continue to pay annual donation.

Further, he stressed upon the need for young members to take up more responsibilities in the affairs of ACUK. He remembered the gracious services and un-conditional support given by the seniors and founder members who built this Association 44 years back.

I also thank all who has graciously contributed for the Umpires Day function and saw that the funds of the association do not lessen.

I place on record the excellent effort put in by our Treasurer in maintaining books of accounts accurately including taking timely decisions on investment and keeping ACUK finances adequate at all times.

WELFARE CUM BENEVOLENT FUND

As on 31.03.2018, the total amount standing under this head is Rs. 2,41,561. This year we have given Rs. 25000/- as grant-in-aid to the bereaved families as per the bye-law provisions.

MEMBERS

The total membership as on date is 467. It is heartening to note that many aspiring umpires are very eager to get their applications accepted for

membership. Working Committee has been approving new memberships / upgrading membership through periodical vetting and rounds of discussions. The deserving applications were considered for fresh membership and upgradation. The breakup of membership as on date is 236 Life Members (including 9 Members who were upgraded to Life Members) 40 Life Associate Members, 184 Members (Including 14 New Members upgraded) and 7 Associate Members, 62 Associate members were upgraded as members on their qualifying. MINUTES OF 43rd ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING OF ASSOCIATION OF CRICKET UMPIRES KARNATAKA (ACUK) HELD ON MONDAY THE 26TH JUNE 2017 FROM 10.00 A.M. AT 4TH J CORPORATE HALL, KSCA, BENGALURU.

- 10.00 : President Shri VN Kulkarni greeted all the members present at the 43RD AGM of ACUK and convened the meeting to order, as the required quorum had been reached by 10.00 A.M. to commence the proceedings.
- 10.05 : Shri. Kulkarni, from Gulbarga rendered the invocation.
- 10.07 : Hon. Vice-President Shri. G. Arunkumar while making his welcome address, expressed special appreciation to the members of Zonal Forums across the state for having made it possible to attend this AGM from distant places.
- 10.10 : A minute of silence was observed in respect of departed members. Shri. Arunkumar briefed on the major events like Umpire's Day, AGMs, SGM etc., that took place during the tenure of 2015-17 and expressed his happiness on the co-operation extended by all the WC members and especially lauded the way many issues were handled smoothly and successfully by President, Shri. V.N. Kulkarni and said mobilising funds for ACUK through various sponsors and sources by Hon. Secretary Shri. B K Kumar was certainly commendable.

THE AGENDA FOR THE 43rd AGM.

- 1011 : Hon. President informed the house that it was a great honour to have the august presence of our founder member and former test umpire Shri Satyajji Rao, senior members Shri. B R Keshavmurthy, Shri. A.S.R. Iyengar among others at this AGM. He further said that the Agenda for the AGM be adopted which was posted to all the members along with AGM Notice, Annual Accounts, various Statements and Hon. Secretary's Report indicating overall activities of ACUK that took place during the tenure 2015-17. The members unanimously adopted the same.

THE PRESIDENTIAL ADDRESS.

While delivering his presidential address, Hon. President expressed his appreciation of all the WC members and the general membership for their active participation, involvement and punctuality in attending various important meetings throughout the period. He stated that Shri. Nandan has made his International Debut in ODIs and wished him all the very best for getting into the ICC Elite Panel of

Umpires at the earliest. He further stated that there is, yet another landmark achievement made by Shri. Shahvir K. Tarapore who has officiated in 100 1st class matches for which BCCI and KSCA honoured him.

While speaking on the latest developments, he stated that as many as 22 umpires from Karnataka have passed the BCCI L1 examination. He also briefed on the communication released by MCC on the latest changes made to the Laws of Cricket which would be implemented from Oct'2017. He said the same would be circulated for the benefit of members.

The President expressed his appreciation on the KSCA's fortitude in chalking out various plan of action from time to time for the benefit of young and upcoming umpires in order to bring more clarity in implementing latest changes to the rules and laws that helps fine tuning of umpiring as well as scoring. He urged upon aspiring umpires to gear up to absorb these changes effectively.

Commenting on the functioning of Zonal Forums, he lauded all the good work made by Shivamogga Forum and said further that they are doing exceedingly well especially celebrating its Silver Jubilee successfully in a grand manner. He urged the Mysore forum to be more active as they have great potential and requested Mangalore Forum to be more active. The President concluded his address by extending a wholehearted thanks to all the members for attending the 43rd AGM and giving him a patient hearing.

THE CONFIRMATION MINUTES OF 42ND AGM.

- 10.29 : While the President sought the approval of the house for the confirmation of Minutes of 42nd AGM, former Hon. Secretary of ACUK, Shri NRS Prabhu expressed that there is no necessity of using the word “ SURPRISE ” in the 4th paragraph of Page No.25 of 43rd AGM Notice pertaining to admission of umpires who are on probation.
- 10.32 : The Hon. President clarified that the recording of the minutes of meeting of AGM cannot be changed unless there is a mistake or some important points left out. He further clarified that the MINUTE has been recorded on the actual happenings and deliberations that took place and not that it has been prepared outside the AGM and approved by the working committee. While concluding his speech, he informed the house that merits and de-merits of previous Minutes of Meeting can be discussed separately and requested Shri. Prabhu to take up this issue under the agenda point “Any Other Subjects”.
- 10.41 : Shri. Shahvir K. Tarapore suggested that clarifications sought by members should be cleared up before going for confirmation of Minutes of previous AGM.

- 10.44 : Shri. B.K. Ravi explained that members are aware of the procedure wherein Minutes of previous AGM would have well discussed and approved by the Working Committee and circulated amongst its members. He further reiterated that no other member has reacted or responded to any of the points as recorded in the Notice of 43rd AGM which was posted to all the members adequately before the AGM.
- 10.52 : Shri. K.C. Shekar proposed and Shri. A.C. Subbuswamy seconded for the confirmation of Minutes of 42nd AGM. Hon. President informed the house that confirmation of the Minutes of 42nd AGM is read and accepted.

THE CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF SGM.

- 10.55 : Hon. President requested the house to confirm the Minutes of Special General Body Meeting held on 26.2.2017 in order to have Bye-Laws of ACUK amended. Hon. President informed that all the relevant points were discussed in detail at the SGM and it has been circulated and accepted with little changes made wherever necessary.
- 10.58 : Shri. Shahvir K. Tarapore informed that Point No.8(dii) should have been 8(fi) in Page No.31. After due deliberation, the house approved that 8(dii) is corrected one and to be read as it is.
- 11.02 : Shri. S.M. Ananthakrishna proposed and Shri. Krishnamurthy from Shivamogga Zone seconded for the confirmation of Minutes of SGM. Hon. President informed the house that confirmation of the Minutes of SGM is confirmed.

THE ADOPTION OF HON. SECRETARY'S REPORT.

- 11.05 : Hon. President requested the house to take as read and adopt the Hon. Secretary's report as it has been circulated well in advance.

Shri. B.V. Venkatesh wanted to know why Working Committee should be thanked in the Secretary's Report. Shri. S.M. Ranganath also expressed that thanking is a very good gesture and it is not a mistake.

Hon. President clarified that it is just a formality to thank even it is their own body. Shri. B.K. Ravi proposed and Shri. S.M. Ranganath seconded. Hon. President informed the house that the agenda point No.6 – Secretary's Report has been read and accepted.

THE ADOPTION OF AUDITED FINANCIALS

11.06 : Hon. Treasurer Mr. P Muralidhara moved the financials for adoption on the request of the President. Shri. B.V. Venkatesh suggested that “New Investment” need not be put in Receipt & Payments account. And also suggested that Income should be shown on the left side. As regards, Sundry Income, he suggested to change it to “Suspense Account”. Shri. B.K. Ravi clarified that unless there is specific reason, it cannot be put in suspense account. Hon. President appreciated the above observations and said that we are following the tradition of ACUK however the points were well taken.

Hon. President further informed that the house of the very good efforts put in by Hon. Treasurer in preparing and maintaining proper accounts of ACUK. Shri. N.R. Gopal proposed and Shri. Raghu Prasad from Shivamogga Zone seconded. Hon. President informed the house that the agenda point No.7 – Audited Financial Report has been read and accepted.

ANY OTHER MATTER WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR.

11.08 : To a query raised by Shri NRS Prabhu, Hon. President has informed the house that such of those words which does not keep members comfortable and cause annoyance would be looked into and taken out of while finalising Minutes of Meeting in future.

As regards Shivamogga Forum making a resolution in order to strengthen its financials, collecting Rs.50/- from its members per match of umpiring, Hon. President, informed that the Forums are free to adopt certain resolutions which may help them but it should not be deprived of money that parent body, ACUK should get subscription and other dues as per the bye-laws of ACUK.

Further, as was approved in one of the earlier AGM, the issue of payment of annual donation of Rs.300/- by the members came up for discussion. Since many members expressed that it should be dispensed with, Hon. President sought the mandate from the house whether it should be continued or not as there are quite number of members who refrain from paying their annual donation of Rs.300/-and no action can be taken against them since the bye laws are silent. On

the issue, Shri. K.C. Shekar suggested that donations from members should be voluntary and should not be compulsory.

Shri. B.K. Ravi suggested that the decision of AGM to collect the payment of Rs.300/- towards annual donation be discussed by the new Working Committee in due course of time. Shri. B.K. Keshavaram from Bengaluru.
